CONTRACT AND RULES FOR AFTER SCHOOL & SUMMER PROGRAM

This Contract is entered into between the Farmington Hills Area Youth & Family Services Program, Youth Member and Parent / Legal Guardian, as stated above.

Members hereby agree to abide by all of the rules and policies as designed by the staff and members of the Youth Center, as stated below:

1. Member will be responsible to notify parent/legal guardian of their daily plans for after school or summer activities and arrange for their own transportation home by the time the Youth Centers are scheduled to close at 5:30.
2. **\$50 annual fee to become a Youth Member for the 2015-2016 school year. * Clarenceville non-residents an additional \$70 per trimester. We follow the FPS calendar.**
3. **There will be a \$10 fee for replacement photo ID cards.**
4. Member will be responsible for any damage they cause to any Youth Center site. Members should return any equipment in the same condition at the end of the day prior to leaving the Youth Center. *If not, the member will be responsible for replacing any equipment checked out that is lost, missing, or damaged.*
5. Member agrees to abide by the bus rules and be on their best behavior on the bus and at the Youth Center.
6. **NO** fighting, smoking, drugs or alcohol, or weapons of any kind.
7. All members shall remain in Youth Center room(s) at all times.
8. Appropriate language will be used at the Youth Center at all times.
9. Common sense rules will be in place and are to be followed by Member at all times.
10. Violations of any of the rules at the Youth Center(s) may jeopardize your privileges in the program and could put your membership at risk.
11. Members are responsible for their electronic devices. Youth Center employees are not responsible, in any way, for the loss, theft, or damage to electronic devices (phones, iPads, etc.) brought to Youth Center by Members. Inappropriate use of electronics could result in suspension of the privilege.
12. **We expect our Youth Members to follow the FPS dress code.**

BUS RULES FOR YOUTH CENTER PROGRAM

Violations of any bus rules may jeopardize your bus privileges. This includes riding the bus for daily pick up and field trips during the summer and after school programs.

There will be no appeal process for removal from the bus.

REMEMBER... THE BUS DRIVER IS THE BOSS!

1. No standing.
2. No switching seats.
3. No hands or objects hanging or thrown out the windows.
4. No throwing of objects at people on the bus.
5. No pushing or shoving.
6. **ABSOLUTELY**, No profanity.
7. No yelling. Talk in normal voice tones only.
8. No teasing or bullying.
9. No eating or drinking.
10. **ABSOLUTELY**, No smoking or use of illegal substances.
11. Any other inappropriate behavior that may arise.

Bus transportation to the Youth Center is a *privilege*. Members are expected to exhibit good behavior and follow all bus rules.

Failure to exhibit good behavior will result in:

FIRST OFFENSE: **Warning! Notify the member's school.**

SECOND OFFENSE: **Parent / Guardian notification by letter then any additional offenses will result in loss of bus privileges.**

THIRD OFFENSE: **Loss of bus privilege for the year**
