

Snow Plowing Guidelines

The Division of Public Works provides snow and ice control services for a network of major roads, school bus routes, and subdivision streets. Major roads and school bus routes receive the highest priority and are plowed and salted following any significant accumulation of snow or ice. Local streets, however, are plowed only if the snow reaches a depth where travel is not possible. If the accumulation is less, subdivision streets are spot salted on hills, curves, and intersections. To supplement the City's plowing, individual residents or homeowner associations can request that the City place 55-gallon drums filled with a mixture of sand and salt at intersections and hills.
