CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS MAJOR ROAD PROJECTS

13 Mile Road Rehabilitation, Farmington Road to Orchard Lake Road
This project is substantially complete and open to traffic.

Gill Road and Colfax Street
This project is substantially complete and open to traffic.

Drake Road Rehabilitation, 13 Mile to 14 Mile Road
This project is substantially complete and open to traffic.

CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS LOCAL ROAD PROJECTS

Briar Hill Subdivision
This project is substantially complete and open to traffic.

Hollywood and Westhill Woods Subdivisions
This project is substantially complete and open to traffic.

Independence Commons Subdivision
Work on this project is wrapped up for the 2016 season and will resume in the spring of next year. Old Homestead is the only remaining roadway that needs to be completed at this time.

COUNTY PROJECTS

Middlebelt Sewer Transport and Storage Tunnel (I-696 to Northwestern Highway)

Middlebelt Road has been reopened between Highmeadow and Wellington; however, lane closures will be utilized to accommodate the remaining work items over the next several months. Restoration of the site and landscaping will be completed in the early spring when weather allows it.

Middlebelt Road Culvert Replacement (South of 11 Mile in front of Kroger)

This project is substantially complete and open to traffic.

8 Mile Concrete Repair Project (Metroview thru the Farmington Road Intersection)

This project is substantially complete and open to traffic.
