New Legislation Impacting Voter Registration

Recent legislation has impacted voter registration procedures. The Farmington Hills City Clerk wants all residents to be aware of the following information:

- All qualified individuals will automatically be registered to vote when performing a driver's license or personal identification card transaction at a Secretary of State branch office, unless the person declines.
- The deadline to register to vote at a Secretary of State branch office, by mail or online, is now 15 days prior to an Election.
- After the 15-day deadline and through 8 p.m. on Election Day, individuals may register to vote **in person** at their local City Clerk's Office with proof of residency.

In order to register to vote:

- You must be a citizen of the United States.
- You must be a resident of the State of Michigan and at least a 30-day resident of the city in which you are registering by Election Day.
- You must be 18 years of age or older by Election Day.
